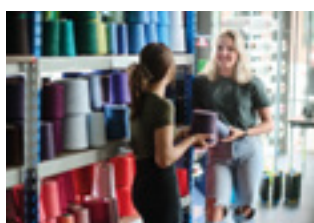

- Deventer is one of the oldest cities in the Netherlands. The city has a medieval town quarter and the houses display typical Dutch architecture.
- Deventer is ideally located. From Deventer, it is possible to reach Amsterdam by direct train in 1h20 or be in Germany in less than an hour by car. Public transport is very efficient in the Netherlands so you can reach other cities by train easily.

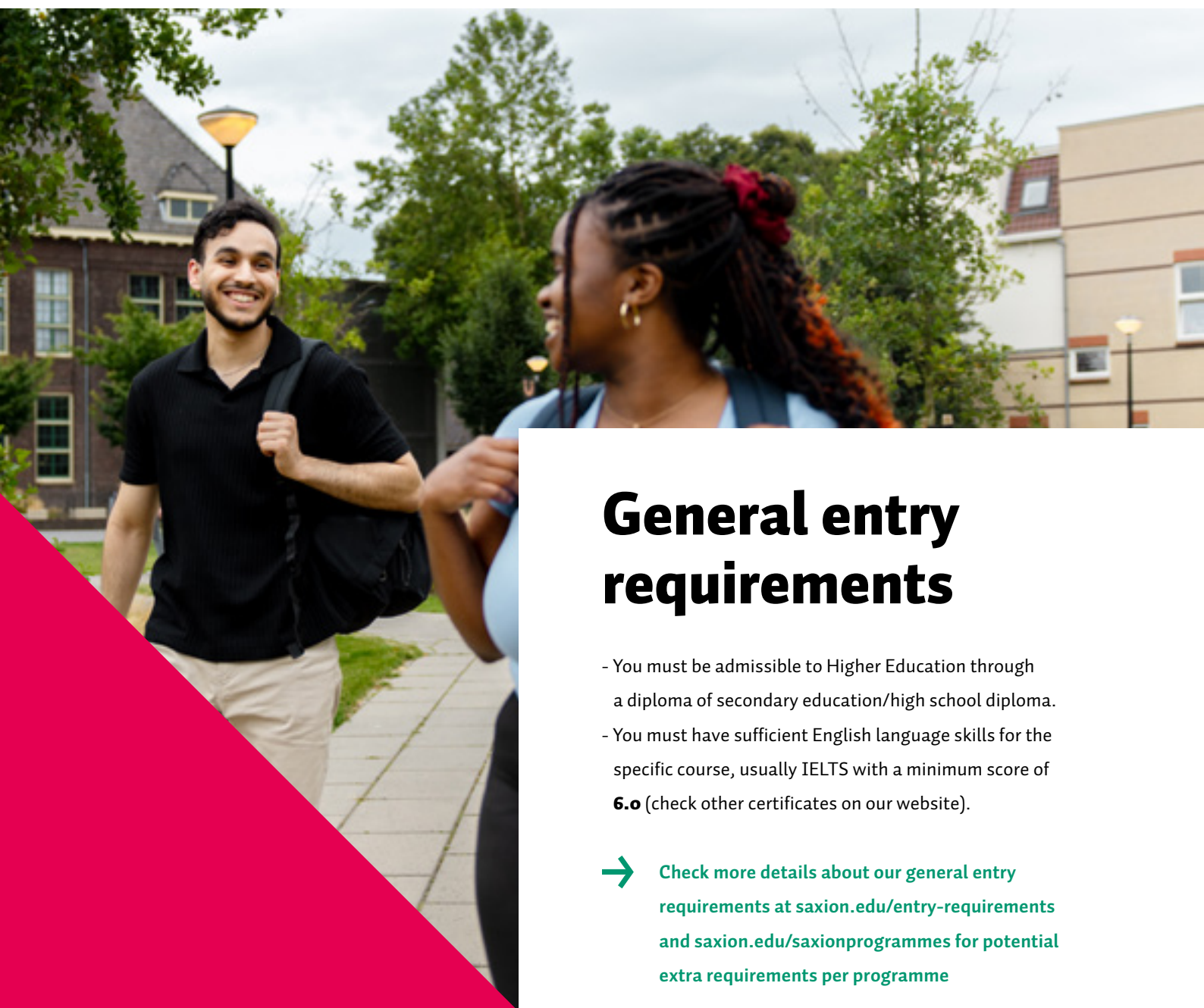

- You must be admissible to Higher Education through a diploma of secondary education/high school diploma.
- You must have sufficient English language skills for the specific course, usually IELTS with a minimum score of **6.0** (check other certificates on our website).

Scholarships

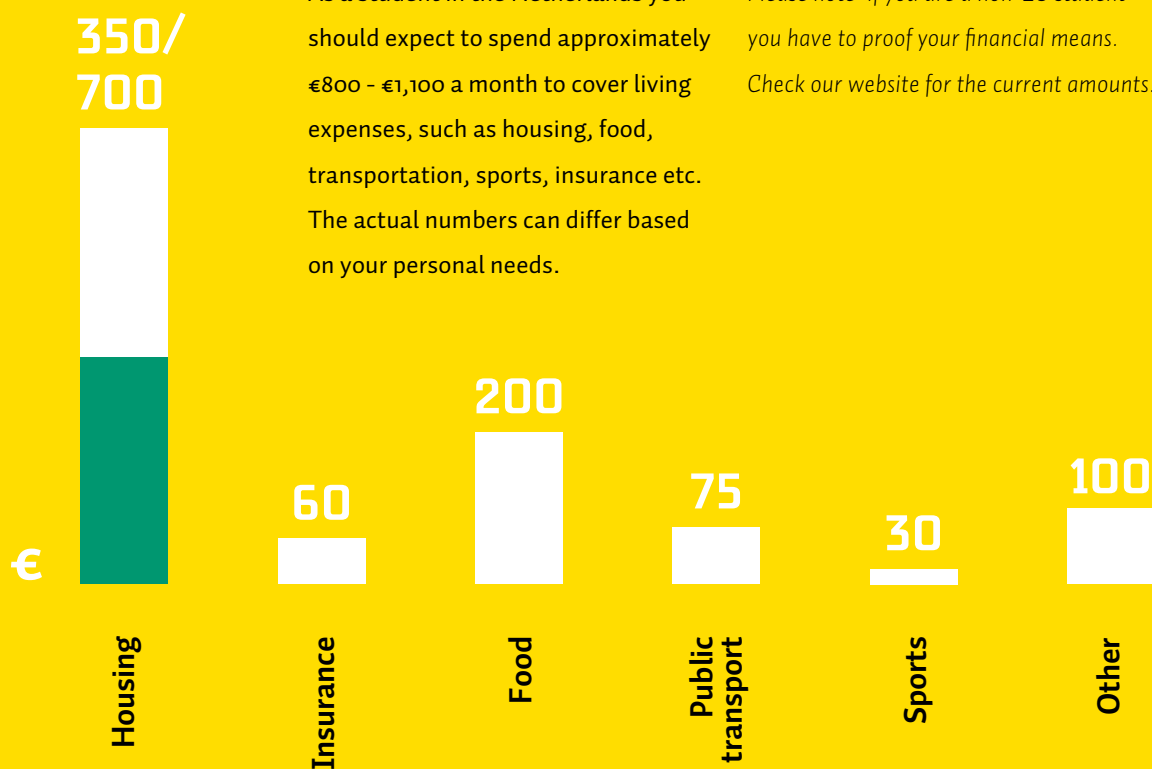
Saxion offers several scholarships ranging from **€2,500** to **€5,000** for excellent and very talented students from outside the EU/EEA.
